Methodology:

This poll was conducted between April 9-June 15, 2020 among a national sample of 3000 Gen-Zers (13-23). The interviews were conducted online and the data were weighted to approximate a target sample of Gen-Zers (13-23) based on age, gender, and race. Results from the full survey have a margin of error of plus or minus 2 percentage points.
