Crosstabulation Results

Methodology:

This poll was conducted between April 9-April 11, 2021 among a sample of 1000 UK Adults. The inter-interviews were conducted online and the data were weighted to approximate a target sample of Adults based on age, gender, educational attainment, and region. Results from the full survey have a margin of error of plus or minus 3 percentage points.
