Crosstabulation Results

Methodology:

This poll was conducted between May 20-May 22, 2021 among a sample of 1000 Employed Adults. The interviews were conducted online and the data were weighted to approximate a target sample of Employed Adults based on gender, educational attainment, age, race, and region. Results from the full survey have a margin of error of plus or minus 3 percentage points.
