Crosstabulation Results

Methodology:

This poll was conducted between April 26-April 27, 2021 among a sample of 1000 Canadian Adults. The interviews were conducted online and the data were weighted to approximate a target sample of Canadian Adults based on age, gender, educational attainment, and region. Results from the full survey have a margin of error of plus or minus 3 percentage points.
