*Methodology:*

This poll was conducted between July 13-July 19, 2021 among a sample of 15401 Adults. The interviews were conducted online and the data were weighted to approximate a target sample of Adults based on gender, educational attainment, age, race, and region. Results from the full survey have a margin of error of plus or minus 1 percentage points.
