Crosstabulation Results

Methodology:

This poll was conducted between October 9-October 11, 2021 among a sample of 572 Parents. The interviews were conducted online and the data were weighted to approximate a target sample of Parents based on gender, educational attainment, age, race, and region. Results from the full survey have a margin of error of plus or minus 4 percentage points.
